13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

This safety project will construct 1/3 mile of 10-foot-wide, ADA compliant concrete trail to improve pedestrian and bicyclist safety on busy South Keller Road, which has more than 17,000 average daily vehicle trips. The addition also will interconnect with two existing segments of an area-wide recreational trail network. The goal is to provide a dedicated path for cyclists who often share the road with cars and to reduce pedestrian road crossings between adjacent properties that include apartments, office buildings and the FBI Orlando field office.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The trail will provide life-safety and recreational benefits with a dedicated path to help keep pedestrians and cyclists away from Keller Road. The trail will also interconnect with existing segments of Maitland's area-wide recreational trail system, providing a multi-modal alternative to motor vehicles.



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c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

A completed ADA-compliant multi-use trail will help to safely facilitate cyclists and to reduce pedestrian crossings on South Keller Road, which is surrounded by large office buildings, apartments and commercial properties. The addition also will tie into Maitland's area-wide recreational trail system that connects with the city's executive and residential areas.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Pedestrians and bicyclists, including employees of several large office buildings and residents of apartments in the immediate area. It is estimated that approximately 1,500 individuals will be served annually. This part of South Keller Road accommodates more than 17,000 average vehicle trips each day. North and South Keller Road within Maitland city limits had 79 vehicle crashes sine 2020.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Construction of the South Keller Road Multi-Use Trail will provide a safe connection for pedestrians and cyclists in the city. City of Maitland Parks and Recreation staff members will conduct periodic counts of trail users to track usage.
