a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

One of UCF's oldest buildings, Howard Phillips Hall is consistently ranked within the university's Facilities Condition Assessment as a priority due to aging systems and the overall condition. Funding would support a full renovation of the interior of the building and building systems, in addition to comprehensively reconfiguring the building to optimize space utilization and support the strategic goals of the university. The renovation would allow the university to co-locate student success departments to better serve students, downsize underutilized office space, and create new spaces that better support learning trends and student needs.

After funds are expended for the remodeling and renovation, Howard Phillips Hall will house a new Student Success Center and will provide academic advising, financial aid, registrar and career services for UCF students.
