Funds will support the Sunshine Genetics Pilot Program, a part of Florida Institute for Pediatric Rare Diseases at FSU's College of Medicine, providing opt-in genetic testing for newborns, improving early detection and treatment. Additionally, funds will create the Sunshine Genetics Consortium to facilitate collaboration and data-sharing among researchers and healthcare providers.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The funds will support genetic testing for newborns through the Sunshine Genetics Pilot Program, expanding early detection of pediatric rare diseases. Services will include multidisciplinary clinical care, genetic counseling, and patient advocacy for affected families. The program will also foster research collaboration through the Sunshine Genetics Consortium, collecting and analyzing deidentified data to advance medical knowledge. Additionally, healthcare professionals will receive training to enhance diagnosis and treatment capabilities for rare diseases.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The funding will provide opt-in genetic testing for newborns, offering early detection of rare diseases. Families will receive comprehensive clinical care, genetic counseling, and patient support services. The institute will train healthcare professionals, improving diagnosis and treatment statewide. Through the Sunshine Genetics Consortium, data-sharing will enhance research, benefiting children.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population for this project includes newborns and children diagnosed with pediatric rare diseases, as well as their families. Additionally, healthcare professionals in the fields of genetics, pediatrics, and rare disease management will be served through training programs. The program aims to serve thousands of newborns in Florida through the opt-in genetic testing during the pilot program. It is expected that hundreds of healthcare professionals will benefit from the training and education initiatives. The Sunshine Genetics Consortium will facilitate broader collaboration, impacting a significant number of research institutions and medical centers across the state.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefits of this project include improved health outcomes for children with rare diseases through early diagnosis, reduced healthcare costs via early intervention, and enhanced expertise in rare disease management. Families will receive critical support, and the project will advance research in pediatric rare diseases. Outcomes will be measured by tracking the number of newborns screened and diagnosed, monitoring health improvements through early treatment, evaluating the success of healthcare professional training, and assessing the effectiveness of the Sunshine Genetics Consortium through collaborative research and data sharing.
