13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

There has been massive growth in the City of Belleview, new commercial and residential developments are in various stages of planning and building. The construction of this water main will allow this growth to continue without causing issues with capacity and fire flows in the current line, The looping of our system provides reliability and less stress on the exisitng system.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The construction of a 20"/12" water main from SE 119th Street to US Hwy 441 which will eliminate a dead end line and provide better pressure, fire flows and services to citizens and businesses. The additional line will help provide fire flow for a potential Big Box store on US 441.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The citizens will receive a more efficient water system. The current water mains If these lines reach capacity new customers cannot be added and there is potential for frequent repairs and road closures to rectify any issues on the aging lines that are currently serving those areas. This may cause traffic issues as US Hwy 441 and US 301 are main thoroughfares serving Marion County, Ocala, Belleview, and other residents and commuters. The looping of the system will provide increased reliability for the system.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The City of Belleview serves approximately 8,000 people in the area with water services and approximately 75,000 people driving through Belleview each day on US Hwy 441 and US 301.
