pavement to accommodate 4-ft-wide bike lanes and 1-ft buffer on each side of the road, as per FDOT Standard Index 711-002. c. Motorists, pedestrians, and bicyclists who travel the area will benefit from safer road conditions and improved traffic

flow. d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population includes residents of North and South Miami-Dade County who use the road regularly.

The expected outcome of this project is to improve transportation conditions for all pedestrians, bicyclists, and motorists traveling through SW 82 Avenue by providing safer and more favorable transportation conditions.
