Ba sh in ea fa	The Project will enhance the Bal Harbour south inlet waterfront corridor, a critical public access route adjacent to Baker's Haulover Inlet. The improvements will address documented safety concerns along a narrow and heavily used shoreline path that lacks adequate railings, controlled access points, and emergency response features. The scope includes new over-water lookout platforms to reduce crowding, steps to provide safe and stable access to the water's edge for first responders, shade structures to protect pedestrians from heat stress, and pedestrian railings to prevent falls. These upgrades will reduce risk of injury, improve storm surge and emergency response conditions, and ensure safe year-round use for residents, visitors, and public safety personnel.

13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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The funds requested will enhance public safety along the Bal Harbour waterfront by constructing designated overlooks, shade structures, and pedestrian railings that prevent falls, reduce crowding, and provide controlled access to the shoreline. These improvements will create a safer environment for residents, visitors, and first responders year-round.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Activities and services will include construction administration, installation of over-water lookout platforms, pedestrian railings, shade canopies, steps to the water's edge, and placement of site furnishings, lighting, and signage, all coordinated to improve safety, comfort, and guided public access along the waterfront corridor.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The project will provide citizens with direct services including safe and continuous public walking access along the waterfront, shaded rest areas and overlooks for comfort, safe vantage points and steps for interaction with the water's edge, and improved safety through railings, lighting, and wayfinding signage

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The project will serve residents, visitors, and first responders by improving safety along a high-traffic public waterfront corridor. The area is one of Bal Harbour's most visited locations and attracts a significant number of tourists each year. More than 3,000 individuals are expected to benefit from these improvements annually.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected outcome of the project is improved safe and enjoyable public access to Bal Harbour's waterfront, with enhanced comfort, designated overlooks, and guided pedestrian circulation that reduces unsafe off-path use and protects the shoreline. Success will be measured by completion of the constructed improvements within scope and budget, compliance with permitting and safety standards, and observable increases in safe public use as documented through site inspections, maintenance records, and visitor feedback.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?

In the event that Bal Harbour Village fails to meet specified deliverables or performance measures outlined in the contract for administering appropriated funds, clear penalties should be incorporated into the contract's terms.
