The additional funds will allow ZeroEyes deploy it's technology across already existing cameras to monitor for guns on campus - creating a safer school environment.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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ZeroEyes will deploy server capacity to install the technology and then begin monitoring thousands of cameras across

the district for brandished firearms, and providing 24/7 human verification monitoring, troubleshooting / maintenance, quarterly software updates.

Citizens with children enrolled in the district will benefit with the added layer of protection at their kid's schools, while also making the schools not appear like a heavily guarded facility because the software layer sits on top of the already existing camera infrastructure. d.
