The funds will be used to upgrade and expand classroom technology to support digital learning, improve instructional delivery, and enhance student engagement. The goal is to ensure that all students have access to modern, reliable technology that aligns with state curriculum standards and prepares them for college and career readiness in a digital economy.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Project activities include the purchase and installation of updated classroom technology such as interactive displays, student devices, secure network infrastructure, and instructional software.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This project will directly benefit students, teachers, and the broader school community by providing access to advanced instructional technology and digital resources. Citizens will also benefit through improved educational outcomes, better preparation of students for the workforce, and expanded opportunities for technology-driven community education programs.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population includes approximately 2300 students and 188 instructional staff members who will utilize the upgraded technology daily.
