The purpose of this funding will be to purchase a new fire engine for the Quincy Fire Department (QFD).

The intended purpose of this funding request is to purchase a new fire engine. This will give the fire department the equipment necessary to answer calls. Quincy is approximately 12 square miles with roughly 8,000 residents. There is a great need for a new truck. In nearly three years the fire department has answered more than 2500 calls.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The health and safety concerns for citizens in both the City of Quincy and Gadsden County are of utmost importance. The QFD is in dire need of a new pumper engine with a water capacity of at least 1,500 - 2,000 gallons. The 2 pumper engines we have now are over 20 years old and constantly in need of repairs. One is a 2002 and the other is a 2003. Constant issues with these include not holding needed air pressure.

The target population served is expected to be the entire City of Quincy along with supporting neighboring communities with fire service needs.
