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Perform a complete battery of tests for the transformer (built in 1990), replace all gaskets, and have it painted, Replace the existing 69 kV circuit switcher with a 69 kV circuit breaker already purchased, Install new 69 kV hookstick switches on the voltage side steel structure, and Install refurbished control building for all relay and control equipment.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The substation is currently comprised of antiquated and potentially dangerous components, leaving the citizens of Quincy vulnerable to prolonged outages and endangering workers. The proposed improvements will replace these components, mitigating these risks.

The entire city will be impacted by funding to upgrade the electric substation.
