c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The substation is currently comprised of antiquated and potentially dangerous components, leaving the citizens of Quincy vulnerable to prolonged outages and endangering workers. The proposed improvements will replace these components, mitigating these risks.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The entire city will be impacted by funding to upgrade the electric substation.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected outcome will be a reduction in loss of power for long periods of time through out the service area. This can be measured by pulling an outage report and it being better than past years in the length of time of the power outage.
