### 13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

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Facility expansion on TSC property in Gadsden County to provide for four programs: First, an increase in the number of residents obtaining GED credentials. Second, expand healthcare education programs which will produce students with an industry certification and immediate employability. Third, grow the HVAC program to meet employer demand. Fourth, replicate a successful Leon Country program for students with intellectual disabilities in Gadsden to obtain employment credentials.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

These funds will be used to construct a new approximately 8000 sf building on the TSC main campus, for expansion of the HVAC and healthcare programs and for GED classes and a program for adults with intellectual disabilities that will lead to employment credentials.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

These programs will provide educational opportunity to citizens in the region and will make high-wage and high-demand jobs available to them. it will produce qualified individuals to fulfill a great need in the community. Gadsden 20% are in poverty; 21% aged 25+ don't have high school degree/GED. With GED avg wage increase is \$700/month (US Census). HVAC is second highest paying blue collar job in Florida (CBT.edu). Average HVAC salary in Gadsden is \$53,000 (NBLS). HVAC and healthcare are top 30 job in MSA (FLChamber, indeed.com) This expansion will allow TSC to serve more individuals.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Expansion of the TSC Gadsden Center will serve individuals looking for stable careers with potential for high wages (average \$53,000).

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Training students to enter high-wage and high-demand jobs in the region; increase number of GED completers to improve economic opportunity; and provide job skills for adults with intellectual disabilities. Track the number of students enrolled in the programs, graduates and employment data.
