4. Project/Program Description

Nathan Benderson Park is strategically located central to the North Port-Sarasota-Bradenton Metro Area to provide continuity of the operation of essential school, local government services, and intergovernmental coordination during and after major storm events. The building will be built to Threshold Building standards that provide increased wind load capacity in a centrally located area for the regional and in an area outside of designated evacuation zones or mapped flood zones. The facility will serve as a regional evacuation, shelter, recovery facility, staging lineman and food services, mobile hospital setup, etc. In addition to the evacuation functions, the facility will be a county-owned property that offers a number of benefits to the surrounding counties including providing a new 100,000 square foot Indoor Multi-Sports Complex, including, but not be limited to basketball, pickleball, tennis, volleyball, wrestling mats, a museum, and event space
