a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Building a workforce equipped to meet the demands of advanced manufacturing sectors, including aerospace, industrial fabrication, and infrastructure construction, fueling local talent pipelines with skilled welders and pipefitters prepared for evolving technology and industry standards is the specific purpose of special appropriations request.



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b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

By establishing state-of-the-art welding and pipefitting labs, we aim to enhance student preparedness for high-wage manufacturing jobs through rigorous technical skill proficiency and real-world practice; support accelerated workforce credentialing by providing pathways to nationally recognized certifications such as AWS Certified Welder in multiple welding processes and pipe welding.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Expand access to hands-on training for diverse populations including veterans, underemployed workers, and high school dual enrollment students, addressing Florida's critical labor shortages in manufacturing trades. Foster strategic industry partnerships facilitating apprenticeships, internships, and direct employment pipelines within Florida's growing manufacturing economy.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Jobless person, economically disadvantages persons, at-risk youth, homeless, high school students, college students, formerly incarcerated persons will be served by this project. 50-100 persons are expected to be served each year.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The appropriation request is critical for preparing a highly skilled manufacturing workforce in Florida. Modernizing our welding labs with industry-standard equipment and expanding pipefitting fabrication facilities will provide students hands-on training in high-demand skills such as SMAW, GTAW, and advanced pipe welding techniques essential for the manufacturing and construction industries.
