a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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The building addition will achieve multiple goals. Increased Public Safety: A modern, well-equipped dispatch center will enhance the ability to dispatch first responders to emergencies and maintain public safety. Enhance Law Enforcement Training: A spacious training facility will allow us to host quality training classes for GCSO and surrounding agencies. Community Outreach: the training facility will also be used for community outreach programs. Cost Savings: The renovation of the existing dispatch center and training room will allow us to create much needed office space and improve operational efficiency.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Dispatch services: The building addition will improve our ability to properly dispatch law enforcement services in Gulf County. Training services: The new training facility will provide the opportunity to train more efficiently with larger classes and allow on site training for new curriculum. Community Engagement: The training facility will also be used for community outreach programs, meetings, and events to foster better community relationships.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Enhanced dispatch services: Improve response times for law enforcement, ensuring the safety and security of the county. Better Trained Law Enforcement Officers: Law enforcement will be better trained and able to serve the community better. Community Outreach Programs: community meetings, workshops, and events aimed at building relationships & trust between law enforcement and citizens.

The target population served by this project include all residents and visitors of Gulf County. This population encompasses a diverse demographic including families, business, and tourists seeking various services from the Gulf County Sheriff's Office. This project will serve all the residents, businesses, and tourists seeking law enforcement services from the Gulf County Sheriff's Office.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Benefit: Enhanced dispatch services: Improve dispatch environment and response times for law enforcement, ensuring the safety and security of the county. Measuring Benefits: Monitor response times and dispatcher retention. Benefit: Better Trained Law Enforcement Officers: Law enforcement will be better trained and able to serve the community better. Measuring Benefit: Monitor hours of training and citizen complaints. Benefit: Community Outreach Programs: community meetings, workshops, and events aimed at building relationships & trust between law enforcement and citizens. Measuring benefit: Number of meeting and community contacts.
