a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Funds will be utilized to upgrade Liberty County's Fire Rescue radio equipment to the P25-compliant SLERS Phase 2, ensuring statewide compliance and unifying communication for Fire, EMS, and the Sheriff's Office. This enhances interoperability, improving coordination among local, state, and federal agencies for more effective response efforts. The upgrade also strengthens first responder safety and mutual aid support to neighboring areas.

Enhanced, secure, reliable Fire Rescue radio communication services to ensure first responders are able to quickly and accurately provide emergency response services to the county and to provide mutual aid to surrounding areas.

Direct services provided to citizens are the improvement of communications for Fire Rescue providing greater interoperability and safety for first responders, as well as reducing emergency response times, injuries, fatalities, and property damage.

The target population for this project are the citizens and visitors of Liberty County that would benefit from the improvement in Fire Rescue communications and increased efficiency between agencies that provide emergency response at the local level.
