d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Citizens in North Florida College's six-county service district - Jefferson, Taylor, Madison, Lafayette, Hamilton, and Suwannee counties - are the target population. This project will allow for sixty-three (63) more students to enroll in the college's welding program per academic year. This program will operate Fall, Spring, and Summer terms and will operate night and day classes and will provide certificates in Welding Technology and Advanced Welding Technology.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

This Legislative Appropriation will allow North Florida College to expand high-demand workforce program offerings for many years into the future. The welding program is a high-wage program that will provide highly qualified workers to the College's service district and throughout the State of Florida.
