To qualify to be in the school, students must be legally blind, have peripheral field loss, or have a neurological visual impairment inhibiting vision. The services provided on sight are standard curriculum instruction, braille instruction, assistive technology instruction, expanded core curriculum instruction, and low vision accommodations (such as large print, screen reader technology). The instruction includes teachers of the visually impaired, O & M Specialist, ESE certified teachers, Occupational Therapist, Physical Therapist, and Speech Therapist.

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The Miami Lighthouse Academy will utilize the requested funds, to provide additional services and materials for Kinder-3rd grade students who are blind/visually impaired to be given the expansive supports needed to adapt, modify, and be provided access to the general education curriculum and activities of daily living skills.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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Providing educational opportunities for students with visual impairments requires an explicit hands-on approach that implements materials and requires key support personnel. Services include: Direct on site services by Teachers of the Visually Impaired which include braille instruction, low vision adaptations, blind specific curriculum (expanded core curriculum) instruction.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Miami Lighthouse for the Blind- in collaboration with Miami-Dade County Public Schools - offers a learning environment for kindergarten, first, second and third grade blind and visually impaired students. Miami Lighthouse is the first vision rehabilitation educational institution using the State of Florida Standards and Benchmarks for Excellent Student Thinking (BEST).

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Grade school students that are blind or visually impaired, persons with poor physical health, developmentally disabled, physically disabled.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The Miami Lighthouse Academy provides services for students who are Blind/Visually Impaired who live within Miami-Dade County, Florida. The academy provides services for Miami-Dade County Public School Students who are visually impaired from K-3rd grade.
