a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The funding will directly benefit regional residents, including law enforcement which heavily uses the range, by providing a safe, accessible, and modernized public shooting and training facility. Improvements support law enforcement and community firearm education, ADA access, recreational programs, and competitive events, ensuring long-term use of a heavily used Broward County public amenity.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The demolition of deteriorated range structures, construction of new canopies, shelters, and roofs, installation of LED lighting and wood baffling, replacement of floors with concrete slabs, addition of ADA-compliant parking and walkways, and construction of a new cart and equipment storage facility.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This project will provide a safe, accessible, and modernized public shooting and training facility. Improvements support law enforcement and community firearm education, ADA access, recreational programs, and competitive events, ensuring long-term use of a heavily used Broward County public amenity.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Citizens in the region seeking to use the target range including police officers. 30,000+ individuals are expected to be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

This project will create a safer environment for citizens, law enforcement training, and recreational users, reducing risk of injury and improving overall range safety. The improvements include hardening the structures for hurricane resistance.
