### 13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The Lord's Place is seeking funding to build a small youth center on its family campus that houses 37 families, including 70 school aged youth. The facility would provide a safe place for children to get additional academic supports, engage in healthy play, and be provided with healthy snacks/meals during out of school time.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

A new youth center would allow us space to have tutoring, life skills classes, a community kitchen where families can learn how to cook, and have recreational space for the children to learn and grow. Other youth development and prosocial activities will take place at the youth center throughout the week as well.

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c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Minimally 70 children will receive education and youth development services (not covered by this request). This will divert children from at-risk behaviors and provide a sense of normalcy for children that would have otherwise been homeless.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

School aged children who would otherwise be homeless, who are economically disadvantaged and at-risk.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Children residing at The Lord's Place Family Campus will have the opportunity to attend the youth center during out of school time, receive tutoring services and academic supports, life skills sessions, healthy eating demonstrations, and prosocial activities. This will keep youth out of trouble and safe while their parents work toward economic self-sufficiency. Each child's grades and academic progress will be tracked, as well as their attendance to the youth center each day/week.
