a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The funds requested will be used to reduce neighborhood flooding, improve stormwater capacity, and enhance public safety by constructing new and upsized stormwater inlets and pipes, adding exfiltration trenches, and building a new stormwater pump station with injection wells. These improvements will increase system reliability, protect infrastructure, and improve roadway access during heavy rain events.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Activities and services funded through this request will include engineering design, permitting, and construction of key stormwater infrastructure improvements. These activities include installing new and upsized stormwater inlets and pipes, constructing exfiltration trenches, and developing a new stormwater pump station with injection wells. Project management, inspection, and testing services will also be provided to ensure the system operates effectively and meets all regulatory standards.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The appropriation will provide direct services to residents by reducing flooding in neighborhoods and public roadways, improving stormwater drainage, and enhancing overall public safety during heavy rainfall events. Citizens will benefit from more reliable roadway access, reduced property damage, improved water quality, and faster drainage due to upgraded stormwater infrastructure and the new pump station. These services directly improve quality of life and community resilience.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population served by this project includes residents, businesses, and visitors within the affected drainage basin and surrounding neighborhoods.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected outcome of this project is a significant reduction in neighborhood and roadway flooding, improved stormwater management capacity, and enhanced public safety and mobility during heavy rainfall events. The upgraded drainage infrastructure—including new and upsized inlets and pipes, exfiltration trenches, and the stormwater pump station—will increase system reliability and reduce the frequency, duration, and severity of flood conditions.
