13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Request \$10,000,000 towards construction of the Balm Road Super Pump Station Project, a critical component of the One Water Program, designed as a long-term solution to deliver reliable, resilient, and sustainable water service to meet the demands of the approximately 145,000 residents, and rapidly growing, who live and are moving into the south-central service area of the County.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funds will be spent on the construction cost associated with One Water - Balm Road Super Pump Station project.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?



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A new pump station with the capacity to pump up to 56 million gallons of wastewater a day to the new wastewater treatment facility; this project is a key component to providing a long-term solution to provide reliable, resilient, and sustainable water service

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Current population of 145,000; however, the area is rapidly growing and the population is expected to increase in the coming years

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Expanded wastewater capacity reduces the risk of sanitary sewer overflows (SSO) - which is both a health and environmental hazard. Accommodating for additional growth in the southern portion of Hillsborough County.

Reduction in SSOs in the Southern portion of Hillsborough County. Increase in population and development in southern Hillsborough County.
