Practices and games will be held here as well as community events. The current state of track is a liability and hazardous.

The track can be used as a walking/recreational track for after school, the Fall Festival, Homecoming Events, church and community events. It will be ADA compliant so we can foster an inclusive and equitable environment for all citizens of Franklin and surrounding counties.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The targeted population includes the majority of the citizens in Franklin County, Florida. Elderly persons, persons with special needs, economically disadvantaged, at risk youth, preschool students, students grades K-12, college and university students.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The benefit will be the overall accessibility and required updates to host community events, sporting events as well as community based events in a safe, friendly environment. Success will be measured by the number of events hosted annually.
