a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Playground improvements to the Village of Biscayne Park's only Tot Lot for a community of 3,300 residents and surrounding neighborhoods. This Tot Lot is utilized by three (3) neighboring jurisdiction, North Miami, El Portal Miami Shores and Unincorporated Miami Dade County. The Tot Lot Equipment is over tenth-five (25) years with replacement parts increasing harder to get.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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Funds will be utilized to service the recreational needs for families with small children - ages 0-5 years old. The Tot Lot is currently heavily used both during the week-day and on weekends. It is used and enjoyed by the community for families of all economic/ social backgrounds.

Citizens from the surrounding neighborhoods benefit from use of an recreational area that is a has safe equipment and meets the needs of the community.

The target population served by this project will be preschool students, grade school students and families. No more than 800 individuals are expected to be served.
