13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

This project includes a \$330,000 contribution from Lake-Sumter State College for a total project cost of \$950,000. This project will include the implementation of ZeroEyes surveillance system, additional cameras, and lockdown readiness improvements on all campuses.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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This project will enhance security across all Lake-Sumter State College locations through advanced surveillance, upgraded infrastructure, and modernized access controls. Funds will support implementation of the ZeroEyes surveillance system, which uses artificial intelligence to detect threats and accelerate emergency response. Outdated locks and door hardware will be replaced or upgraded to enable rapid lockdown capabilities and add remaining buildings into the centralized access control system.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The upgrades foster a secure learning environment where students (and their families know) can focus on their education with confidence in their personal safety and wellbeing. This infrastructure supports proactive threat prevention and emergency responsiveness essential for student protection on campus.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is Lake and Sumter Counties. As the fastest growing college in the FCS for two straight years, Lake-Sumter currently serves 11,500 students each year and continues to expand its enrollment to serve additional learners throughout the community.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The project creates a safer campus where students and employees feel secure, fostering a positive learning environment. Outcomes will be measured by incident reports and system reliability checks.
