The additional funds will allow ZeroEyes to be installed on significantly more cameras across the district. The more ZE coverage there is, the more protected students will be from potential gun violence.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

ZeroEyes will add server capacity and begin monitoring ~850 more cameras across the district for brandished firearms, 24/7 human verification monitoring, troubleshooting / maintenance, quarterly software updates

Citizens with children enrolled in Seminole County Public Schools will benefit with the added layer of protection at their kid's schools, while also making the schools not appear like a heavily guarded facility because the software layer sits on top of the already existing camera infrastructure.

The target population are the students, teachers, and staff that work and learn at SCPS. The student body alone is more than 67,000.
