Funding will enable citizens to earn certifications through individualized workforce training, secure employment with job placement support, and attain long-term housing and financial stability.

Jobless persons and economically disadvantaged persons

Eighty (80%) percent of active participants will secure employment or increase their income after program completion and Seventy-Five percent (75%) of active participants will achieve and maintain employment for at least six months. The methodology by which the outcome will be measured through job placement records, employment verifications, and participant income reports. Further self-sufficiency will be measured through employment verification, and follow-up participant surveys.
