Installation of the infrastructure necessary to address rainwater up to the 5-year storm.

Funds will be used for permitting, materials and labor required for installation of flap gates on existing outfalls, restoration of roadways and swales and Construction Engineering Inspections.

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Stormwater infrastructure will increase the overall water storage capacity of the basin and help alleviate neighborhood flooding from 3-year and 5-year storms.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

NE 2 Avenue is the primary access road for approximately 100 single-family houses and serves approximately 400 individuals.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The project will help alleviate neighborhood flooding from 3-year and 5-year storms. Staff will monitor future storms and measure the impact of major rain events on the neighborhood.
