Phase I of the project consists in the replacement of existing outfall pipes and installation of automatic sluice gates at 4 locations where City canals connect to the C-13 Canal. The proposed gates will alleviate flooding in canal zone 2, and 3 while implementation of the proposed skimmers will minimize the migration of floatable contaminants, debris and vegetation from the C-13 to the City canal network and vice versa. In addition, 8 water level stage recorder will be installed at strategic locations within Canal Zones 2, and 3 to help better operate the proposed gates.

Phase I of this project replaces existing outfall pipes and installs automatic sluice gates at four City canal connections to the C-13 canal. These gates will alleviate flooding in canal zones 2 and 3, while the skimmers will minimize contaminant migration between the C-13 and City canals. Eight water level stage recorders in canal zones 2 and 3 will be installed to help better operate the gates.

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This project will alleviate recurring flooding in canal zone 2, and 3 and increase water quality of the City canal network.
