Section 741.465, Florida Statutes, is 14 created to read: 15 16 741.465 Address Confidentiality Program for Victims of Domestic Violence; certain information exempt from 17 disclosure. -- The addresses, corresponding telephone numbers, 18 19 and social security numbers of program participants in the 20 Address Confidentiality Program for Victims of Domestic Violence are exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of 21 22 the State Constitution. For purposes of this section, the term "address" means a residential street address, school 23 address, or work address, as specified on the individual's 24 25 application to be a program participant in the Address 26 Confidentiality Program for Victims of Domestic Violence. 27 This section is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review 2.8 Act of 1995 in accordance with s. 119.15, and shall stand repealed on October 2, 2003, unless reviewed and saved from 29 30 repeal through reenactment by the Legislature. 31

1 Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public necessity that the addresses, corresponding telephone numbers, 2 3 and social security numbers of program participants in the 4 Address Confidentiality Program for Victims of Domestic 5 Violence be exempt from public records requirements. Release 6 of this information would significantly threaten the safety 7 and security of program participants. Therefore, the harm 8 that would result from such release outweighs any public 9 benefit that might result therefrom. 10 Section 3.
