| C. | Facts of the Case: Four-year old Tirini Riley suffered from tracheostenosis, a narrowing of the trachea which restricted breathing. On July 27, 1993, she was admitted to Hollywood Memorial Hospital to undergo a laryngeotracheoplasty, a procedure designed to alleviate this condition. During recovery, Tirini Riley suffered cardiopulmonary arrest, resulting from a blockage of the endotracheal tube. She has been left in a state of static encephalopathy (a condition which prevents her from responding to her environment), and requires around-the-clock care. | | | | |
