## I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Architects Incidental Trust Fund without modification. The Architects Incidental Trust Fund is administered by the Department of Management Services.

Section 215.196, F.S. creates the trust fund, provides purpose and revenue sources.

#### 2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The re-creation of the Architects Incidental Trust Fund would provide funding for the operation of the Division of Building Construction within the Department of Management Services.

#### 3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

There are three primary sources of funding for the Architects Incidental Trust Fund; construction fees, permit and inspection fees, and interagency agreements.

#### B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.
