I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Aircraft Trust Fund without modification. The Aircraft Trust Fund is administered by the Department of Management Services.

A. PRESENT SITUATION:

1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

Section 287.16, F.S. creates the trust fund, provides purpose and revenue sources.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The re-creation of the Bureau of Aircraft Trust Fund would provide funding for fuel and maintenance costs of the executive aircraft pool within the Department of Management Services.

3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The primary sources of revenues for the Bureau of Aircraft Trust Fund are transfers from the General Revenue Fund and user charges for air travel.

B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.
