I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Surplus Property Revolving Trust Fund without modification. The Surplus Property Revolving Trust Fund is administered by the Department of Management Services.

1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

Section 217.07, F.S. creates the trust fund, provides purpose and revenue sources.

2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The re-creation of the Surplus Property Revolving Trust Fund would provide funds for the administration of the Surplus Property program within the Department of Management Services.

3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The primary source of revenues for the Surplus Property Revolving Trust Fund is proceeds from service charges.

B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.
