## B. Procedural Summary

A wrongful death action was brought by the estate of Arthur D. Messick for failure of Collier County to properly mark an intersection of a county road and a canal. Arthur D. Messick was a passenger in the vehicle. The case went to jury trial. The jury found Collier County 85% negligent and the driver 15% negligent. Judgment for claimant was entered for \$201,639.55 against Collier County. The County has paid \$100,000.00.

## C. Facts of the Case

On October 6, 1990, Arthur D. Messick was a passenger in a truck that plunged into a canal in a remote area of Collier County. Mr. Messick and another passenger in the vehicle drowned. Collier County was found 85% negligent for failure to properly warn of an existing hazard, or to replace warning signs. Mr. Messick had no spouse or children. Beneficiaries are his estate and his parents.
