Except as otherwise provided herein, this act shall take effect October 1, 1995; and section 787.025, 15 Florida Statutes, as created by this act, and shall apply to 16 offenses committed on or after that date. 17 Section 2. It is the intent of the Legislature that 18 19 the applicability provision relating to criminal offenses 20 which was enacted in section 64 of chapter 95-228, Laws of Florida, should apply solely to the creation of section 21 22 787.025, Florida Statutes, relating to luring or enticing a 23 child, as indicated by Committee Substitute for Senate Bill 1536, as filed and first passed by the Senate on May 3, 1995, 24 25 and which was the original basis of chapter 95-228, Laws of 26 Florida. The Legislature finds that as a result of the 27 amendment of such bill on May 5, 1995, by the House of 28 Representatives, which was concurred in by the Senate on the 29 same day, such applicability was inadvertently attributed to 30 other provisions of law for which it was not intended. 31
