Section 8. The Division of Statutory Revision of the Joint Legislative Management Committee, in editing manuscript for the next official version of the Florida Statutes, is directed to replace the term "Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles" wherever that term appears in the statutes with the term "Department of State" or "Department of Highway Safety," as appropriate.

Section 9. This act shall take effect January 1, 1998, except that the Governor and Cabinet may appoint the executive director of the Department of Highway Safety 60 days prior to the effective date of this act.
