## II. Summary of Amendments Contained in Message

**Senate Amendment 1** conforms the House bill to the Senate CS, making the House bill identical to the Senate CS by Criminal Justice. HOUSE CONCURS

**Senate Amendment 2** changes an appropriation requirement concerning the state attorneys. It changes proviso language associated with Specific Appropriation 620 in the Conference report on HB 4201. This amendment would remove the requirement that such appropriation is not contingent upon the implementation of a quarterly workload report. This appropriation pertains to funding for a computer system for the state attorneys. THE HOUSE REFUSES TO CONCUR AND REQUESTS THE SENATE TO RECEDE FROM THIS AMENDMENT.
