Participation in the program shall not exceed a 23 period of 10 years from the date of enrollment in the tuition assistance program, or shall continue until graduation or 24 25 termination of the full-time or part-time student, whichever occurs earlier. 26 27 2. HOUSE SUMMARY Revises language with respect to the educational tuition assistance program administered by the Department of Military Affairs to exempt members of the Florida National Guard from payment of tuition and fees regardless of the date that the person becomes a member of the guard.
