The 16 17 private vendor The warden of the state prison shall designate 18 the executioner. Information that which, if released, would 19 identify the executioner is confidential and exempt from the 20 provisions of s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution. The warrant authorizing the execution shall be 21 22 read to the convicted person immediately before execution. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 23 24 law. 25 26 27 SENATE SUMMARY Provides for a private vendor to execute persons sentenced to death in this state pursuant to a contract with the Department of Corrections.
