At the general election held in November 1998, each special district, as defined in section 189.403, 13 Florida Statutes, which has the power to impose ad valorem 14 taxes shall have placed on the ballot a referendum in which 15 the electors of the district may vote on the following 16 17 question: 18 19 Shall the District be abolished? 20 Yes 21 No22 23 The governing body of each district shall certify the results of the referendum on that district to the Legislature by 24 25 January 1, 1999. Section 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, 26 27 each special district, as defined in section 189.403, Florida 28 Statutes, which has the power to impose ad valorem taxes may 29 not impose such a tax, or increase the rate of one already in 30 existence, unless the electors of the district approve such change in a referendum.
