LEGISLATIVE SUMMARY б Provides an additional ground for the termination of parental rights when the parent is unable to discharge parental responsibilities due to a chronic history of abuse of drugs, controlled substances, or alcohol, the parent has been offered the opportunity to participate in a drug or alcohol treatment program and has failed or refused to do so or has failed in treatment. Provides that any substance-abuse problem that has existed in excess of 1 year is considered to be "chronic."
