Subsection (2) of section 817.567, Florida 10 Statutes, is amended to read: 817.567 Making false claims of academic degree or 11 12 title.--(2) No person awarded a doctorate degree from an 13 institution not listed in subsection (1) shall claim in the 14 15 state, either orally or in writing, the title "Dr." before the person's name or any mark, appellation, or series of letters, 16 17 numbers, or words, such as, but not limited to, "Ph.D.," "Ed.D.," "D.N.," or"N.D.,""D.Th.,"which signifies, 18 19 purports, or is generally taken to signify satisfactory 20 completion of the requirements of a doctorate degree, after the person's name, unless the degree is from an institution 21 22 unrecognized by the state or by the Federal Government and that fact is disclosed, either orally or in writing. 23 24 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 25 law. 26 27 2.8 SENATE SUMMARY Provides that a person who discloses that a doctorate degree is from an unrecognized institution is not in violation of the prohibition against making false claims 29 30 of academic degrees. 31 1
