I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Administrative Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2000. The Administrative Trust Fund, FLAIR #44-2-021, is administered by the Department of Banking and Finance. This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 1996, by Chapter 95-69, Laws of Florida.

II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:

A. PRESENT SITUATION:

1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

Sections 17.076, 68.092, and 77.0305, F.S. provide revenue sources for the fund.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The trust fund supports the department's Division of Administration.

3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The major sources of revenue for this fund are administrative assessments against departmental trust funds. According to Comptroller data, receipts to this fund for FY 1997-98 were \$6.8 million.

B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.

C. STATUTE(S) AFFECTED:

None.

III. FISCAL ANALYSIS & ECONOMIC IMPACT STATEMENT:

This legislation has no fiscal impact on state agencies or state funds, on local governments as a whole or on the private sector. It simply re-creates, without modification, an existing state trust fund and continues the current use of the fund.
