Section 121.095, Florida Statutes, is 13 created to read: 14 121.095 Florida Retirement System Preservation of 15 Benefits Plan Trust Fund. --16 (1) The Florida Retirement System Preservation of 17 Benefits Plan Trust Fund is created within the Division of 18 Retirement. (a) Funds to be credited to the trust fund shall 19 20 consist of Florida Retirement System monthly retirement contributions required to meet the requirements for payment of 21 22 restored benefits under the Florida Retirement System Preservation of Benefits Plan, as specified in s. 121.1001. 23 The trust fund shall be maintained and utilized 24 (b) solely for the purpose of providing benefits under the 25 26 Preservation of Benefits Plan, as specified in s. 121.1001. 27 The trust fund shall be separate and apart from (C) 28 the Florida Retirement System Trust Fund. The trust fund 29 moneys and assets shall not be commingled with nor ever receive a transfer of moneys and assets from the remainder of 30 the Florida Retirement System, including, but not limited to, 31 1

the Florida Retirement System Trust Fund, or any other 1 2 qualified retirement plan administered by the Division of 3 Retirement. 4 (d) The trust fund shall be funded on a month-to-month 5 basis. Trust fund assets shall not be accumulated to pay 6 future benefits. 7 (2) Any balance in the trust fund at the end of any 8 fiscal year shall remain in the trust fund at the end of the 9 year and shall only be available for paying administrative 10 expenses of the Preservation of Benefits Plan for the current 11 plan year or for future plan years. 12 (3) The Legislature declares that the Florida Retirement System Preservation of Benefits Plan Trust Fund is 13 exempt from the automatic termination provisions of s. 14 15 19(f)(3), Art. III of the State Constitution. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1999, if 16 HB 1013 or similar legislation is adopted in the same 17 legislative session or an extension thereof, but it shall not 18 19 take effect unless it is enacted by a three-fifths vote of the 20 membership of each house of the Legislature. 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31
