20	Section 1. Section 290.0069, Florida Statutes, is

The б application must be submitted by December 31, 1999, and must 7 comply with the requirements of section 290.0055, Florida 8 Statutes. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 290.0065, Florida Statutes, limiting the total number of enterprise 9 10 zones designated and the number of enterprise zones within a 11 population category, the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development may designate one enterprise zone under 12 this section. The Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic 13 Development shall establish the initial effective date of the 14 enterprise zone designated pursuant to this section. 15 Section 4. Notwithstanding the time limitations 16 17 contained in chapters 212 and 220, Florida Statutes, relating to enterprise zone tax incentives, a business that was 18 19 purchased in February 1992 within an area of Tampa that received a designation as an enterprise zone under section 20 290.0065, Florida Statutes, effective July 1, 1995, and that 21 was eligible to receive enterprise zone tax incentives from 22 July 1, 1995, to July 1, 1998, must submit an application for 23 the tax incentives by December 1, 1999. All other requirements 24 25 of the enterprise zone program apply to such a business. Section 5. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 26 27 law. 28 29 30 31

4	The committee substitute differs substantially from Senate
5	Bill 1510 in that it also allows Suwannee and Columbia 5 counties to apply for enterprise zones and allows a business located in a Tampa enterprise zone to apply for tax incentiv
6	dating back to July 1, 1995.
7	The committee substitute also removes from the bill language exempting Liberty County's enterprise zone application from a
8	statutory provision that does not appear to be applicable to the county's circumstances.
