6	than the amount such customers would have paid under the							
7	modified stand-alone rate structure approved on remand in							
8	Docket No. 920199-WS of the Public Service Commission. The							
9	refund amount for each eligible utility customer shall equal							
10	the amount paid in excess of the modified stand-alone rate,							
11	plus interest.							
12	(2) The Public Service Commission shall notify by mail							
13	each utility customer who is eligible for a refund under this							
14	section and who resides in the state. The notice must include							
15	instructions for filing an application for the refund. An							
16	eligible utility customer must file a refund application with							
17	the Public Service Commission by July 1, 2000, or shall							
18	forfeit eligibility for the refund. The Public Service							
19	Commission shall verify an applicant's eligibility and shall							
20	request that the Comptroller issue payments for approved							
21	applications. The Public Service Commission shall mail the							
22	payments to the refund recipients. An amount of less than \$10							
23	shall not be refunded.							
24	(3) The amount necessary to fund the refund of utility							
25	payments provided under this section is appropriated from the							
26	Florida Public Service Regulatory Trust Fund.
