I. Summary:

This legislation re-creates the Education and General Student and Other Fees Trust Fund without modification, for the period July 1, 2003, through November 4, 2004. By extending the life of this trust fund for this period, the bill puts it on the same review cycle as all other education trust funds.

This bill re-creates section 240.209(3)(e)6, Florida Statutes.

II. Present Situation:

The Education and General Student and Other Fees Trust Fund, FLAIR number 49-2-164, is administered by the Department of Education. This fund was created effective July 1, 1995, by Chapter 95-112, L.O.F. It is being re-created by SB 508 from July 1, 1999, until July 1, 2003.

The purpose of the Education and General Student and Other Fees Trust Fund is to support the instruction and research missions of the State University System.

III. Effect of Proposed Changes:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification from July 1, 2003, through November 4, 2004, to place it on the same review cycle as all other education trust funds.
