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8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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10 Section 1. The baseball field at Florida Agricultural
11 and Mechanical University is hereby designated as the "Oscar
12 A. Moore - Costa Kittles Baseball Field" in honor of their
13 extraordinary leadership ability and outstanding contributions
14 to the university and its students. During Mr. Kittle's
15 tenure as baseball coach, the team won eight SIAC baseball
16 titles, six NAIA district playoffs, and one NAIA national
17 tournament.

18 Section 2. The tennis courts at Florida Agricultural
19 and Mechanical University are hereby designated as the "Althea
20 Gibson Tennis Courts" in honor of the university's star
21 athlete who is a pioneer in the realm of professional tennis
22 as the first African-American to win Wimbledon.

23 Section 3. Building #2, which houses the Colleges of
24 Arts and Sciences and Business at Florida Gulf Coast
25 University, is hereby designated as "Charles B. Reed Hall" in
26 recognition of his tireless and dedicated services as
27 Chancellor of the State University System of Florida and his
28 commitment to the creation and development of Florida Gulf
29 Coast University.

30 Section 4. Building #5, which houses Student Services
31 at Florida Gulf Coast University, is hereby designated as "Roy

1 E. McTarnaghan Hall" in recognition of his 23 years of
2 dedicated service to the State University System and the
3 leadership and vision he exhibited in support of the
4 establishment of Florida Gulf Coast University.

5 Section 5. The Seminole Golf Course at Florida State
6 University is hereby designated as the "Don A. Veller Seminole
7 Golf Course" in recognition of his role in developing Florida
8 State University's athletic program from its formative years
9 to the program of distinction it is today.

10 Section 6. Building 76 at Florida State University is
11 hereby designated as "William A. Tanner Hall" in honor of his
12 contribution to the formation of the Florida State University
13 Police Department and his service to the community as a leader
14 and mentor for 35 years.

15 Section 7. Building 1012, located on the Panama City
16 Campus of Florida State University, is hereby designated as
17 the "Larson M. Bland Conference Center" in recognition of his
18 visionary leadership and guidance as Dean of the Panama City
19 Campus.

20 Section 8. The building known as the Administration
21 Building, located at the University of Central Florida, is
22 hereby designated as "Millican Hall" in recognition of over 30
23 years of tireless and dedicated service of Dr. Charles N.
24 Millican, the founding president of the University of Central
25 Florida.

26 Section 9. The building known as the Humanities and
27 Fine Arts Building at the University of Central Florida is
28 hereby designated as "Colburn Hall" in recognition of Dr.
29 Trevor Colburn, the second president of the university, for
30 his outstanding leadership and dedication to the university's
31 growth.
