18	<u>(a) The department is authorized to allocate and</u>		
19	<u>distribute to each district with schools under probationary</u>		
20	<u>status pursuant to s. 229.0535, Florida Statutes, an amount as</u>		
21	<u>prescribed annually by the legislature for improvement funds</u>		
22	<u>for those schools. The allocation shall be one-sixth of the</u>		
23	<u>product determined by multiplying the base student allocation</u>		
24	<u>times the weighted full-time equivalent student membership for</u>		
25	<u>these schools times the district cost differential.</u>		
26	<u>(b) The funds shall be used only for those schools</u>		
27	<u>under probationary status and may be used for student</u>		
28	<u>performance improvement purposes including, but not limited</u>		
29	<u>to, student remediation activities, teacher training, class</u>		
30	<u>size reduction or extended school year.</u>
